Nature of Water

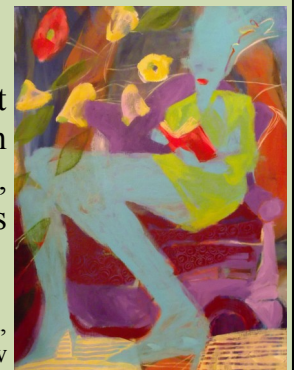
