THREE CITIES ART CLUB WEB SITE UPDATE

Visit our web site, www.threecitiesartclub.org,
which continues to evolve.

It was decided at the last meeting that we will not
have a shopping cart option on our web site - artists
can list their art for sale and buyers will contact them
directly to purchase or commission work and mem-
bership dues can be paid for a the meetings or
mailed in.

If you are interested in selling your art on our web-
site, you need to provide me with a list of the art
(title, medium, size, price including 10% club com-
mission and 6% sales tax and a description of each
piece for association purposes). Pictures of the art
are required, many of which I may already have on
file. Pictures of art can be E-mailed or, if you don't
have pictures of your art, please bring them to a
meeting so they can be photographed. If it is easier
for Members to have me to come to your home to
take the pictures, special arrangements can be made
and a \$10 fee will apply.

We will vote at the May meeting about the fees but
it is my recommendation that Members can post
their art for \$10 (up to 20 pieces), non-members \$20.
Updates and/or additional items at \$2 each or an an-
nual update for \$5 for Members or \$10 for nonmem-
bers. All fees must be paid in advance. These fees
will partially compensate me for my time and par-
tially go to the Club (split to be determined).
