# **Artwork Exhibition Opportunity** at Historic Art Deco Guardian Building

Guardian Arts, a program initiated by Wayne County Executive Robert A. Ficano designed to showcase and promote the fine talents of Wayne County artists while furthering the majestic appeal of the Guardian Building, is currently holding a call for entries. Individual artists, as well as group organizations, are encouraged to submit 2-D and 3-D entries for exhibition consideration.

The newly provided Guardian Arts spaces will provide exhibition for local Wayne County artists to share their unique talents with the multitude of visitors seen on the Executive levels of the Guardian Building each day, keeping in line with the building's own local history, a masterpiece in its own right.

Through the Guardian Arts program, Wayne County hopes to cultivate and foster creativity and provide the independent artist with a place to call home by allotting space at the Guardian for showcase.

Designed by Michigan architects; erected by Michigan contractors; built by Michigan artisans—the Guardian Building became a temple of Michigan commerce and ingenuity after its addition to the Detroit skyline in 1929. In all, forty artisans worked on the structure's painted murals and ceilings, intricate tile work, mosaic and stained glass, marble fixtures and vaulted lobby. The building has been designated a National Historic Landmark, the highest honor given by the National Park Service.

# September Program FIGURE DRAWING



Fremont Thompson, founder of the Green Man Atelier Classical Art Workshops in Farmington Hills, will be lecturing on the 5 Eyed Cube System of Anatomy which the famous anatomist Robert Hale used in his anatomy lectures when he was alive. It

is a method that goes back hundreds of years and upon which Mr. Thompson based his recent summer course at Oakland University. He will be using charcoal to draw the skull and the trunk and may also place muscles if time allows. The lecture is an easy one to follow so if you want to bring your sketchbooks, you can draw along.

If this presentation wets your appetite to learn more about drawing the human form, he will be teaching further anatomy lessons mixed with live figure drawing at his Farmington Hills Studio on Wednesday evenings from 6:00 - 9:00 p.m. He will bring a Green Man course schedule to hand out at the meeting.


