



# February Program John Middlestead TRAINING YOUR EYE TO SEE



This presentation will consist of two components. The first is a 1 hour presentation at our meeting that will highlight the components of a good image. The second component is actually taking images with the camera on your phone or a standalone camera in your favorite

areas. The overall objective is for the attendees to gain an understanding of what makes a good image and putting that knowledge into practice. This is helpful to photographers and painters alike.
