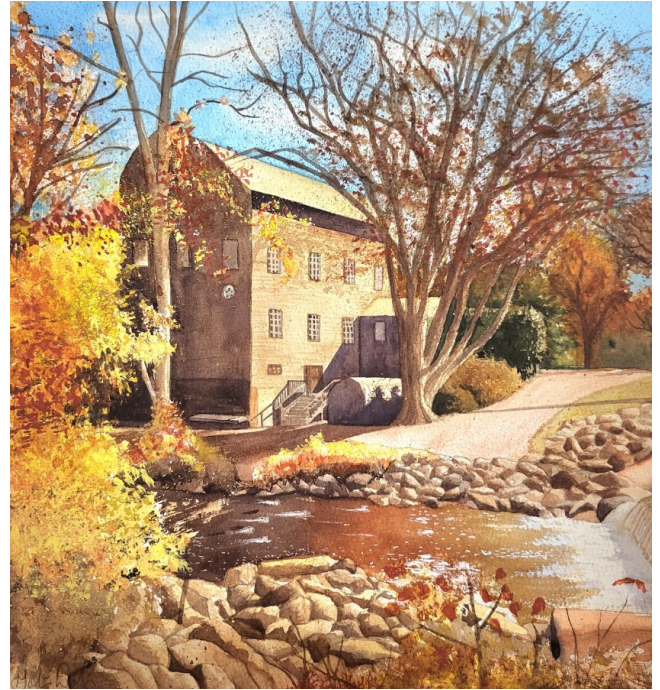




Gabrielle Dolin Artist's Bio
